Course description

Course content includes a lecture about the city of Pécs. Later on several excursions are organised where students visit different places of the rich architectural heritage of Pécs. Finally students have to prepare a study and a poster about one of the visited places.

Aim of the course:

Aim of the course is to give the possibility for foreign students to get to know the rich cultural heritage of the city of Pécs. Pécs with its more than 2000 years long history is a unique city of different ages. The Roman Age, the Middle Ages and the Baroque Age are also present in the city. Different artefacts, objects, ruins and building are presenting these ages to the visitors of the city. Students will have the possibility to see this rich cultural heritage, from the Early-Christian Cemetery to the buildings of the Bauhaus architects.

Requirement to attend the lecture:

Course will start with a minimum number of 3 students. Course can be attended by Erasmus and gradual students.

Requirement of attendance:

Students have to participate on the lectures and on the excursions and they have to present their semester task to the lecturer.

Teaching method:

Lectures are held and excursions are organised during the semester. Students prepare their separate semester task.

Requirements during the semester:

Semester tasks:

Study: collection of contemporary examples related to the task building of the student. Minimally five examples should be presented with sketches, pictures, drawings or plans.

Formal requirements: size: A/4 landscape, documentation should be sent per email in PDF Format to tmolnar@pmmik.pte.hu.

Poster: Students have to prepare a poster in the size of A/3 portrait. Here they have to present the pictures that they made on site or they find on the internet about the building. They have to write a maximal 300 words long personal description about the task project. The poster should be sent per email in PDF Format to tmolnar@pmmik.pte.hu.

Points to be collected during the semester:

study:	10 points	(min. 5 points)
poster:	10 points	(min. 5 points)
Altogether:	20 points	(min. 10 points)

Supplemental possibilities:

Students who cannot attend a lecture can prove their absence according to the prescriptions of the Study and Examination Regulations of the University of Pécs. According to the Study and Examination Regulations, latest date to hand in the semester task is one week after the last lecture, so 18.12.2014.
