Introduction, Learning Outcomes:

The course is designed for students with very basic previous knowledge of the Hungarian language. The aim of the course is to provide students with tools enabling them to successfully manage basic communicational situations in the Hungarian language environment. By the end of the course students will be able to use basic vocabulary and grammatical structures, read and write informational texts, and will have acquired a basic knowledge of the Hungarian culture and geography.

General Course Description and Main Content:

The course will focus on topics, vocabulary and themes including describing people, daily routine, places in a city, means of transport, giving directions, describing countries, food and meals, shopping, restaurants, clothes, free time, hobbies and holidays. Students will also learn basic writing skills (writing emails) and grammar including sentence structure, word order, verb conjugations, suffixes and pronouns.

Methodology:

The course is based on the coursebook 'MagyarOK', Students' Book and Workbook 1. Students will be expected to engage fully in the class through spoken contributions and to complete written exercises both in class and at home.

The course will be held 1 x 1.5 hours per week for the spring semester.
